1. Participation in Greenwich:

- We are young people with SEND.




5. Examples




 ACE suggested changes to make The Local Offer easier for people to read and understand.



- Young people gave their views on activities they would enjoy e.g. outdoor sports.
- They created artwork for the Short Breaks brochure.



- ACE discussed how they travel from home to school.
- They said what is important to them when travelling e.g. feeling safe.



- We looked at the All Services Community website.
- We said what changes we would like e.g. colours.
- We voted on the website name.



 This is one way we can show that we enjoy our meetings.



6. Photos & videos




- The sessions are based on fun activities.

- We keep a record of our meetings in photo books
- We also made our own Wiki.

8. You said, We did: tells us that RBG have listened to us and made changes.




- Have a look at 'You said, We did'.

10. Numbers



- ACE gave a total of 237 views on services for RBG.
- We talked about 11 different topics.



- We gave more views than last year.
- We talked about 1 more topic than last year.
- RBG were better at telling us about changes that had been made.



- 34 of us said what we thought of All Services Hub.
- 25 of us gave views on holiday activities.
- 22 of us said what we thought about transport to school.



12. Opportunities




- Working with GYPC on their meeting that runs each year.
